Hi Sandra,

The Council considered the above consultation and wish to make the following observations in response –

Overall the draft NDP is well written and presented, and the Council and Steering Group are to be congratulated.

This Council notes the potential for Higham Ferrers to expand eastwards beyond the A6 bypass (policy HF.H3) toward this parish, which gives rise for concern for both the additional traffic on the B645 and the reduction of the open countryside between the settlements. Modest developments near the agricultural college may be appropriate, but large developments that extend out and encroach on the skyline would impact on the rural nature and amenity of this parish and should be resisted.
